CALIFORNIA ARCHITECTS BOARD LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS TECHNICAL COMMITTEE SECTION 100 CHANGES WITHOUT REGULATORY EFFECT

The California Architects Board, Landscape Architects Technical Committee hereby proposes to amend and repeal the following sections in Title 16, Division 26 of the California Code of Regulations:

(1) Repeal Section 2611:

2611. Application for Temporary Certificate.

- (a) Application for a temporary certificate shall be made upon the form provided by the board, accompanied by such evidence, statements, or documents as therein required. The application shall be filed with the board at its office in Sacramento and shall be accompanied by the fee required by Section 5681(c) of the code.
- (2) Amend Section 2655 to read as follows:

2655. Substantial Relationship Criteria

For the purpose of denial, suspension, or revocation of the license of a landscape architect pursuant to Division 1.5 (commencing with Section 475) of the Business and Professions Code, a crime or act shall be considered substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a landscape architect if to a substantial degree it evidences present or potential unfitness of a landscape architect to perform the functions authorized by his/her license in a manner consistent with the public health, safety, or welfare. Such crimes or acts shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

(a) Any violation of the provisions of Chapter 3.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
