Hearing Date: April 11, 2011

Subject Matter of Proposed Regulation: Education and Training Credits

Sections Affected: Amend California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 16, Division 26, Sections 2615 and 2620

Updated Information

The Initial Statement of Reasons is included in this rulemaking file. Item Number 5 in the Underling Data was incorrectly indicated as having a date of February 7, 2007.
