The California Architects Board proposed to amend sections 2615 and 2620 of title 16 of the California Code of Regulations. Language is added to section 2615 to allow a candidate who has a Board approved degree in landscape architecture or an extension certificate in landscape architecture from a Board approved school to take the multiple choice sections of the Landscape Architect Registration Examination early. Language is added to section 2620 to allow one year education credit for a degree in architecture which consists of at least a four-year curriculum that has been accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board or partial completion of either a degree in landscape architecture from an approved school or an extension certificate in landscape architecture from an approved school.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 3/7/2012.
